Greetings to everyone at St Michael's Church.

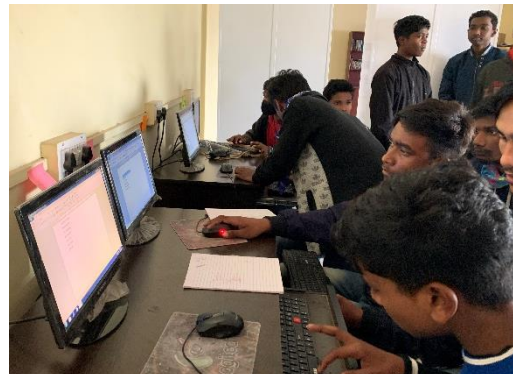
Again it is a joyful privilege to send this update on EBS students.

New printers and scanner.

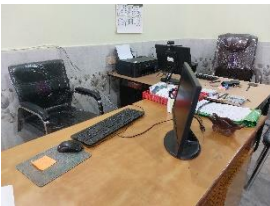
EBS students now have **microphones** for their various classes, retreats and special meetings.
