Sunday

Give thanks for all those who are part of our faithful Tech team, who serve quietly and diligently at our Sunday services and other occasional midweek events. May they all know that their service matters, and ask that they would be encouraged, equipped, and uplifted as they undertake their tasks. Please pray that there would be no technical glitches for those on duty today!

Monday
